


Soil and water conservation techniques	Labour, charrue, herse
Method of fertilizer application:	Poinçonner/ Placement lateral (semis direct)
Amendments:	Ajouter des engrais organiques 30 - 40 t/ha tous les deux ans
Water management:	Diguette, hersage, drainage
Pest management	Recherchez les chenilles légionnaires d'automne et appliquez des pesticides (IPM)
